

# Advanced Google Image Search & Citation

## Advanced Google Image Search on a laptop:

- Open a browser, go to [www.google.com](http://www.google.com)
- Search for your topic
- Click on "Images"
- Click on "Search Tools"
- Click on "Usage Rights"
- Click on "Labeled for reuse"
- Find an image and click on "View Image"
- Right-mouse click on the image and click "Save Image As"
- Copy the URL (link) and paste in your presentation or bibliography

## Advanced Google Image Search on an iPad/iPhone:

- Open a browser, go to [www.google.com](http://www.google.com)
- Search for your topic on the original "All" search tab (not Image tab)
- Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on "Settings"
- Click on "Advanced Search"
- Find Usage Rights, click on "Free to use and share", click "Advanced Search" button
- Click on "Images"
- Click on the image you selected
- Click the three dots and click "View original image"
- Press and hold the image to save or copy it to your presentation
- Press and hold the URL (link) to copy and paste in your presentation or bibliography

Include the link in brackets and today's date (day, month, year).
